ORDER OF DISMISSAL WITH PREJUDICE

THIS CAUSE, having come before the Honorable Susan Stacy at the August 30, 2017 evidentiary hearing, and the Court having heard arguments of counsel and *pro se* Plaintiff and being fully advised in the premises, it is hereby

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

1. Based on arguments by *pro se* Plaintiffs and Defendant at the August 30, 2017 hearing, this Court ruled that Plaintiffs had 15 days from the date of the hearing to provide Defendant with signed medical authorizations and a valid marriage certificate. The Court issued its Order on September 18, 2017.

2. Failure to provide the valid marriage certificate within 15 days would result in dismissal with prejudice of Veronica Amar's consortium claim.

3. Failure to provide the signed medical authorizations would result in dismissal with prejudice of Mark Amar's medical damages claims.

4. On September 13, 2017, Plaintiff provided Defendant a copy of a New Jersey marriage certificate showing a marriage between Mark Amar and Vera Lax.

5. As of the date of this Order, Plaintiff has not provided signed medical authorizations to Defendant as required by the September 18, 2017 Order of the Court.

6. Plaintiff's case is hereby dismissed with prejudice for failing to comply with this Court's September 18, 2017 Order following the hearing on Defendant's Motion to Dismiss for Fraud.

7. Pursuant to the stipulation of the parties at the August 30, 2017 hearing, upon dismissal of the action, the court records for this case shall be sealed.

8. This Court reserves jurisdiction to decide fees and costs.
