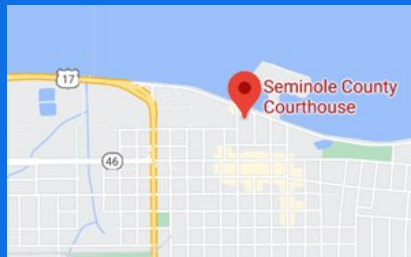

Staff can assist you with:

- Purchasing Circuit or State-Approved law forms and instruction sheets
- Providing resources to help you research court rules, procedures and practices
- Providing resources to help you research how to represent yourself in court
- Telephone numbers for lawyer referral services, legal aid programs and other community resources where you might obtain legal assistance or services

Staff cannot assist with the following:

- Determining which Law Forms best fit your situation
- Evaluating your case or advising whether or not your case should be brought before the Seminole County Court, also known as filing in the correct jurisdiction
- Providing assistance with wording on law forms
- Changing an order signed by a judge
- Giving an opinion or predicting how a judge might rule in your case
- Talking to the judge or relaying a message to a judge or the court

If you do not have an attorney:

- Schedule a consultation through our Self Help Center with a Florida licensed attorney.
- All attorneys are referred by the Orange County Bar Association
- Services provided are not based on income
- Consultations are intended for;
 - Procedural Assistance
 - Form Completion
 - Consultations/Guidance
- Appointments are scheduled in 15-minute increments but no more than one hour per visit
- Walk-ins are welcome as the time slot allows.
- Cost is \$1.00 per minute, non-refundable
- Payment options:

 - Credit/Debit Cards (3.5% convenience fee does apply)
